Arrival

Path to main entrance


- From the car park to the entrance is gravel and then a slab stone path
- The path is sloped.
- There is a single step up into the entrance.






Main entrance

- The main entrance after the step in has another step down into room 1.
- There is a step up toward room 2.





Getting Around Inside

- There are 6 letting rooms, 2 are situated on the ground floor and are connected by an internal door which can be opened to adjoin the rooms.
- The other 4 rooms are accessed via an internal staircase with a hand rail.
- Or an external stone staircase also equipped with a hand rail
